She has translated several of Tagore's works, including *Gora, Boyhood Days, Chokher Bali, Farewell Song: Shesher Kabita* and *The Land of Cards: Stories, Poems and Plays for Children*. Other works in translation include Bankimchandra Chatterjee's *Kapalkundala, In the Name of the Mother* by Mahasweta Devi and *Crossings: Stories from Bangladesh and India*.







How the US, UK turned to India to grapple with communist China in the Cold War era

The establishment of a communist regime in China upended western plans for the post-Second World War Asian order. As the US and the Great Britain grappled with the implications of this new China on their strategic and economic interests in the western Pacific, significant divergences also emerged. A newly independent India seeking to define its place and role in the region under conditions of Cold War was hopeful of enlisting China as partner.

This book outlines India's efforts to craft foreign policy in the context of Anglo-American competition in the Far East. The role of the towering personalities of that era—Nehru, Zhou Enlai, Truman, Eisenhower, Churchill—and the personal chemistry between them, is woven into the narrative to paint a mental picture of the nuts and bolts of Indian diplomacy during the early years.

VIJAY GOKHALE retired as foreign secretary in 2020. He is author of three previous books on China, including *The Long Game: How the Chinese Negotiate with India*.
