Banned by the oppressive British in 1910, *Hind Swaraj* is a clarion call to realize the criticality of unshackling from the bondage of imperialism. It encouraged Indians to take pride in its civilizational heritage. Making Satyagraha as a vantage point to understand Gandhi, it champions non-violent resistance and interdependence for Swaraj.

M.K. GANDHI was born in 1869 in Porbandar, India. He worked to improve the rights of immigrant Indians in South Africa and returned to India in 1915 to take up the struggle for independence from Britain. Gandhi never wavered in his belief of non-violent protests and in 1947, he succeeded in uniting India with a national movement. In January 1948, he was assassinated as he walked to take his evening prayers.
